



# Cost of Union Dues

Union members are expected to pay monthly dues – which are taken out of your paycheck after taxes – and these dues can quickly add up. For example:

If the union's post-tax monthly dues are...	<b>\$35</b>	<b>\$50</b>	<b>\$75</b>
Annual dues (post-tax)	<b>\$420</b>	<b>\$600</b>	<b>\$900</b>
Dues paid over 3-year period	<b>\$1,260</b>	<b>\$1,800</b>	<b>\$2,700</b>
Dues paid over 10-year period	<b>\$4,200</b>	<b>\$6,000</b>	<b>\$9,000</b>

The union sets the dues amount, and members do not get a say in how dues are spent.
